Non-Owner Occupied Short-Term Rental Annual Affidavit

All rental properties located within the City of Colorado Springs must have a valid short term rental license issued by the City of Colorado Springs and must abide by the city's rental licensing requirements prior to leasing any rental property, or room(s) within a property, to another person or persons (City Code Section 7.5.1704).

According to Ordinance 19-101, short-term rentals that are non-owner occupied are precluded in single-family zoning districts and any new non-owner occupied permits are subject to a 500' buffer to another non-owner occupied permit. An owner occupied permit is defined as the primary place of residency of the owner for not less than 185 days per year. By signing below, I,
