<p>1. <u>Alignment with Priorities</u></p> <p>10 points awarded to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities that meet any of the goals of the Pikes Peak Continuum of Care Strategic Plan for preventing and ending homelessness • Activities that deliver a service directly to low- and moderate-income people in targeted neighborhoods <p>All other activities will be awarded 0 points.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	10	_____
<p>2. <u>Activity Need and Justification</u></p> <p>Activities with excellent documentation and justification, quantifiable goals and serving an unmet need will be awarded the maximum of 20 points: good, up to 15 points; average, up to 10 points; and poor, up to 5 points.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	20	_____
<p>3. <u>Organizational Capacity and Readiness</u></p> <p>Maximum points will be awarded to applicants who demonstrate the resources needed to manage the proposed activity (staff, equipment/materials) are available and ready, and the project is not likely to be delayed.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	20	_____
<p>4. <u>Experience and Past Performance</u></p> <p>The experience of the applicant, including the length of time in business, experience in undertaking projects of similar complexity and experience managing CDBG or other federal grant funds will be evaluated.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	15	_____

<p>5. <u>Cost Reasonableness</u></p> <p>The funding request relative to financial and human resources is reasonable and the cost per client is defensible.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	15	_____
<p>6. <u>Activity Sustainability</u></p> <p>Agency has plans to sustain the program after CDBG funds have been expended and demonstrates collaborative efforts.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	10	_____
<p>7. <u>Proposal Quality and Agency Response</u></p> <p>Proposal is complete and information contained in the proposal is accurate. Agency has responded promptly and fully to requests for follow-up information.</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	10	_____
