



# BURN BAN GUIDE



## ALLOWED



### OUTDOOR COOKING

Outdoor BBQ grills fueled by liquid propane gas, natural gas, or liquid fuel.



### OUTDOOR FIREPLACES/APPLIANCES

Outdoor fires contained in portable or fixed fireplaces/appliances fueled **ONLY** by liquid propane gas, natural gas, or liquid fuel.



### OUTDOOR SMOKING

Outdoor smoking in designated areas only. **NOT ALLOWED IN CITY OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES.**



### MAY BE ALLOWED WITH PERMIT

Outdoor hot work activities, such as welding, torching, or blasting in forested or grassy areas.

## ONLY SELECT PROFESSIONAL FIREWORKS DISPLAYS MAY BE ALLOWED

**AFTER AN APPROVED REVIEW, INSPECTION, AND PERMIT IS ISSUED BY CSFD.**

## NOT ALLOWED



### OUTDOOR COOKING

Outdoor cooking, smoking, and grilling in **ALL CITY OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES IS PROHIBITED.**



### OUTDOOR FIREPLACES/APPLIANCES

Any outdoor fire where the fire is contained in a portable or fixed fireplace/appliance that is fueled by solid materials such as wood, pellets, or charcoal.



### OUTDOOR SMOKING

**NO** outdoor smoking in **ALL CITY OWNED PARKS AND OPEN SPACES.**



### RECREATIONAL FIRES

Any outdoor fire or campfire where the fire is not contained in a portable or fixed fireplace/appliance.



### SMALL ENGINE EQUIPMENT

Operating small internal combustion engines such as chainsaws, **WITHOUT** a properly installed, maintained, and functioning spark arrestor (a device that prevents the emission of flammable debris).

## NO PERMITS ISSUED FOR:



- Bonfires
- Model Rockets
- Open or Prescribed Burns

## PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES



- Use of recreational fireworks requiring ignition (has a fuse) such as sparklers, rockets, fountains, etc.
- Burning of trash or rubbish.
