

BUS SERVICE FROM THE CITADEL MALL MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Route 5 runs every 15 minutes from the downtown terminal to the Citadel Mall and changes to Route 25 to The Voyager Transfer Station and then returns every 15 minutes and changes to Route 5 at the Citadel Mall to the downtown terminal.

Route 7 runs every half hour from the downtown terminal to the Citadel Mall via The Printers Parkway and Memorial Park, and then changes to Route 27 to The Pikes Peak Community College. It then returns every half hour to the mall and changes to Route 7 to the downtown terminal.

Routes 10, 11, 27 and 35 also makes connections at The Pikes Peak Community College to The Fountain Buses which runs about every half hour.

Note: The Fountain Buses are not part of our bus system.

Route 6 comes into the Citadel Mall as route 6 and leaves as route 6. It then goes to Filmore and Union and unto Cascade and Filmore where you may transfer to route 6, 9, 17, and 19.

Route 6 changes to route 17 at Filmore and Cascade to The VA Clinic and Uintah Gardens Shopping Center.

At the Uintah Gardens Shopping you may transfer to route 16 across the street at Henderson and Uintah to the 8th Street Walmart and onto Navajo and Nevada where you can connect to routes 10 and 11.

After route 17 leaves 19th and Uintah, it continues to Cache la Poudre and Nevada. Route 17 changes to route 8 at Cache la Poudre and Nevada where it continues onto the Citadel Mall.

You may also transfer to routes 8, 9, 12, 17, and 19 at Cache la Poudre and Nevada.

If you get on route 12 at Cache la Poudre and Nevada, it goes right by the Senior Center at 1514 Hancock and continues onto Powers and Palmer Park near Walmart.

Route 8 comes into the Citadel Mall as route 8 and leaves as route 8. At Cache la Poudre and Nevada, route 8 changes to route 17 to the Uintah Gardens Shopping Center and onto the VA Clinic and to Filmore and Cascade. It then changes to bus 6 to the Citadel Mall.

Route 22 leaves the Citadel Mall at .50 minutes past the hour and goes near The Silver Key at Fountain and Hancock. It then continues to Hancock and Academy where you may connect to routes 27 and 32. Route 22 returns to the Citadel Mall the way it came.

Route 23 leaves the Citadel Mall at .20 minutes past the hour and goes behind the Powers Shopping Center on Tutt Road. It then makes a stop near the Costco at Barnes and Tutt before continuing to Austin Bluffs and Academy where you may connect to routes 25 & 34.

Route 34 will take you to The Citizens Service Center. It then changes to route 14 Monday through Friday only. Route 34 runs on Saturdays.

The final stop for route 23 is Morning Sun behind King Soopers. Route 23 leaves Morning Sun at .23 minutes past the hour to the Citadel Mall the way it came.

Remember, route 25 leaves the Citadel Mall about every 15 minutes to The Voyager Transfer Station where you can make connections to route 39 back to the downtown terminal.

Route 25 also leaves the Voyager Transfer Station about every 15 minutes to the Citadel Mall where it becomes route 5 to the downtown terminal.

Route 19 leaving the terminal on the hour changes to route 39 at Eagle Rock at the University Shopping Center and onto the Voyager Parkway at Walmart.

When route 39 returns, it changes to route 19 at Eagle Rock near The University Shopping Center.

Route 19 leaving the terminal on the half hour goes as far as Eagle Rock and returns.

Note: For buses running in the evening and on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, the schedule times are different.
