



PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Colorado Springs is developing its proposed five-year (2015-2019) Consolidated Plan, one-year (2015) Annual Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan for the use of federal block grant funds.

- The Consolidated Plan is drafted to meet federal requirements, as set forth by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and is intended to outline the long-term strategies necessary to address the housing, economic and community development needs of low and moderate income residents of Colorado Springs.
- The Annual Action Plan details the proposed projects, goals, and objectives for each year of five-year plan.
- The Citizen Participation Plan sets forth the City's policies and procedures for public participation.

The Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan are available for review and comment through May 13, 2015. Copies are available at the Housing and Community Initiatives Division office, 30 S. Nevada Avenue, Suite 604, during normal business hours (8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday through Friday). The draft Plan is also posted online at www.coloradosprings.gov/housing.

A public hearing will be conducted on **Monday, May 4, 2015 from 6:00 – 7:30 pm at Pikes Peak Regional Building, 2880 International Circle, 80910** to gather comments on the proposed plans.
