



## Sales and Use Tax Revenue Report

### Revenues remitted to City in June 2019

This report reflects the Sales and Use Tax revenue remitted to the City in June 2019. The majority of these collections represents business activity occurring in the prior month but also includes delinquent filings.

The 2.0% General Fund sales and use tax revenue is used for City operations such as police, fire, street repairs, and park maintenance. The 0.62% Road Repair, Maintenance and Improvement Tax, known as the “2C Road Tax”, is dedicated to road improvement needs. The 0.4% Public Safety Sales Tax is used to fund public safety operating and capital improvement needs. The 0.1% TOPS tax is earmarked for the acquisition, development, and maintenance of trails, open space, and parks.

- Sales and use tax combined – down 1.44% for the month and up 4.07% year-to-date
- Sales tax – down 0.75% for the month and up 4.65% year-to-date
- Use tax – down 16.51% for the month and down 5.81% year-to-date

The 2.0% Lodgers Tax and 1.0% Auto Rental Tax (LART) is used to attract visitors and to enhance the economy of the City and the Pikes Peak Region.

- LART Combined – up 7.03% for the month and up 11.00% year-to-date
- Lodger's Tax – up 6.57% for the month and up 9.84% year-to-date
- Auto Rental Tax – up 13.98% for the month and up 24.35% year-to-date

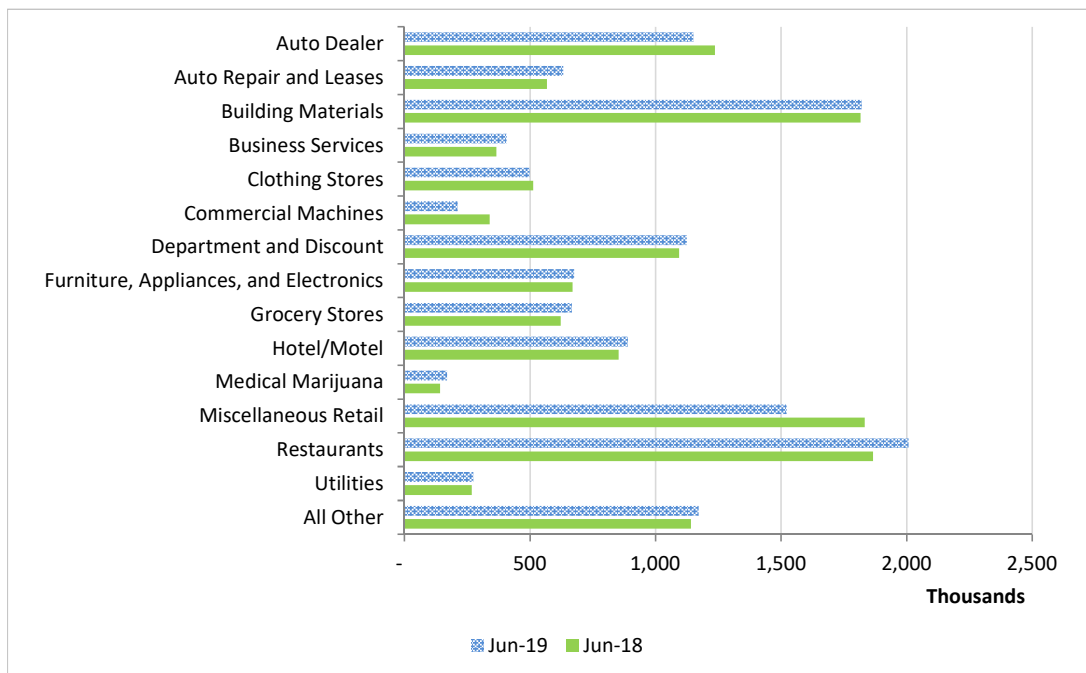
