1. Open Session:

- Approval of Minutes of the Independent Ethics Commission meeting held on December 18th, 2020.
- Review the Code of Ethics, Rules of Procedure, and Open Meetings Law.

2. Closed Executive Session:

In accord with the City Charter Art. III, § 3-60(d) and its incorporated Colorado Open Meetings Act, § 24-6-402(4)(b),(c) and (g), C.R.S., the Independent Ethics Commission, in Open Session, is to determine whether it will hold an electronic Closed Executive Session to discuss Formal Ethics Complaint No. 2021-01. The issues to be discussed involve matters required to be kept confidential by federal or state law or rules and regulations, information protected by deliberative process, and conferences with an attorney for the local public body for the purpose of receiving legal advice. The statutes or rules that are the basis for confidentiality include City Code § 1.3.106(C); Independent Ethics Commission Rules of Procedure 8.0, C.R.S. § 24-72-204(3)(a)(IV)(privileged information); C.R.S. § 24-72-204(3)(a)(XIII)(deliberative process); and City Charter Art. III, § 3-60(d) and its incorporated Colorado Open Meetings Act, C.R.S. § 24-6-402(4)(b),(c).

Upon proper motion, the Independent Ethics Commission Chair shall poll the members of the Commission, and, upon consent of at least two-thirds of the members present, may hold an electronic Closed Executive Session. If consent to the electronic Closed Executive Session is not given, the items may be discussed in Open Session or withdrawn from consideration.
