 - Access to conference room (programming concerns)
- City Auditorium
 - Restrooms accessible
- Parks Rec & Cultural Services Admin Office (E)
- Senior Center & Golf Acres
 - Curb ramp installed, parking lot re-striped
- Streets Division (E)
- Traffic Operations Center (E)

Phase VII

- Pikes Peak - America's Mountain
 - Glenn Cove = new accessible entrance
 - New Summit House
 - Restroom facilities = now accessible
 - Accessibility solutions

Phase VIII, briefly talked about Cemetery and Golf Course Enterprises

Rob opened –up for questions and then asked Kevin McDaniel to talk on Web Accessibility

Kevin, briefly talked about Web Accessibility and how and where the City is at in making its website accessible, to include PDF's and other solutions
