



NOTICE OF CITY SALES AND USE TAX RATE DECREASE TO 3.07%

Why is the tax rate changing?

In 2015, the City's Public Works department made a promise to the community. That promise was to repave 1,000 lane miles in five years using dedicated sales tax funds that voters approved through ballot issue 2C. As of September 2020, we have exceeded our goal and will have paved more than 1,070 miles of road by the end of this year.



Thanks to voters who recognized the success of the 2C program, a five-year extension begins in January 2021 at a slightly lower tax rate

Like the first five years, repaving will continue to take place throughout the city, but we will shift gears to include interior streets, curbs, and pedestrian ramps in addition to continued work on the main roads.

As of January 1, 2021, the 2C Road sales tax rate will be reduced from 0.62 to 0.57 percent (5.7 pennies on a \$10 purchase).

The total combined sales and use tax rate will be lowered from 8.25% to 8.20% as of January 1, 2021.

- 2.9% State of Colorado (state collected)
- 1.23% El Paso County (state collected)
- 1.0% PPRTA (state collected)
