The purpose of this position is to perform custodial duties for assigned facilities and surrounding			
	grounds; perform ongoing routine maintenance, preventive maintenance, basic construction, and		
	at assigned municipal facilities as required; and to ensure work quality and adherence to		
established	established policies and procedures.

40%	Perform a variety of custodial and basic building and ground maintenance services for		
	assigned program. Perform various custodial tasks for assigned facilities; follow		
	approved sanitation and cleanliness standards; clean and mop floors; shampoo and		
	vacuum carpets; clean bathrooms; clean windows; and empty trash receptacles and		
	compactors as needed. Perform basic landscape maintenance activities; maintain		
	flowerbeds and shrubs; remove trash and debris from lawn areas; and operate a		
	snowplow to keep walkways and parking lots free of snow and ice.		
25%	Respond to the more routine heating, plumbing and electrical system malfunctions at		
	assigned facilities; and recommend and perform repairs according to established		
	industry standards. Assist in loading and unloading furniture for removal to storage		
	units; and operate assigned vehicle to retrieve and deliver supplies and equipment.		
20%	Perform preventive maintenance on equipment as assigned; and inspect equipment		
	before use. Complete daily operations reports and logs as assigned. Clean and maintain		
	tools, vehicles, supplies, and equipment. Respond to requests and inquiries from the		
	general public; and provide tours of facilities as requested.		
15%	May prepare public housing units after tenants vacate the premises; ensure that all		
	amenities and systems of assigned housing unit are functioning properly; ensure		
	that all assigned units are safe and fit for dwelling; repaint walls as needed; replace
