



Proposed Service Changes Spring 2022

Digital Public Meeting

Mountain Metro wants to digitally meet with the community it serves to gather feedback regarding proposed service changes for spring of 2022.

Comments will be accepted through March 10, 2022. In accordance with the ADA, anyone requiring an auxiliary aid to participate in these meetings should make the request as soon as possible but no later than two business days (Monday through Friday) before the scheduled event. Citizens who are deaf may also use 711 to arrange for an accommodation.

Proposed Service Enhancements:

Service Restructuring – Route 23 (Galley Rd - Tutt Blvd): MMT proposes to restructure Route 23 by splitting it into two routes, improving frequency, and operating new, battery electric buses. Route 23 would operate from Morning Sun Avenue to Tutt Boulevard and Constitution Avenue, with improved frequency of 30 minutes.

The southern segment of Route 23, from South Carefree Circle to the Citadel Mall Transfer Center would be renamed Route 24 (Galley Rd - Tutt Blvd).

Proposed Implementation: Sunday, April 24, 2022

Service Enhancements (Continued):

Holiday Service Improvement: MMT proposes to improve service on Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day by operating the level of service that corresponds to the day of the week that these holidays fall on. For Monday holidays: Memorial Day and Labor Day, MMT would operate full weekday service. For Independence Day, MMT would operate the appropriate level of service for the day the holiday falls on. Currently MMT operates a Sunday schedule on these three holidays.

Proposed Implementation: Sunday, April 24, 2022
