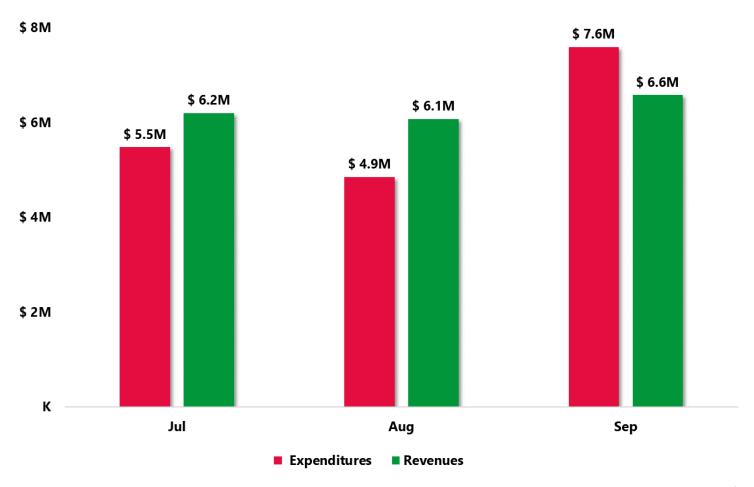

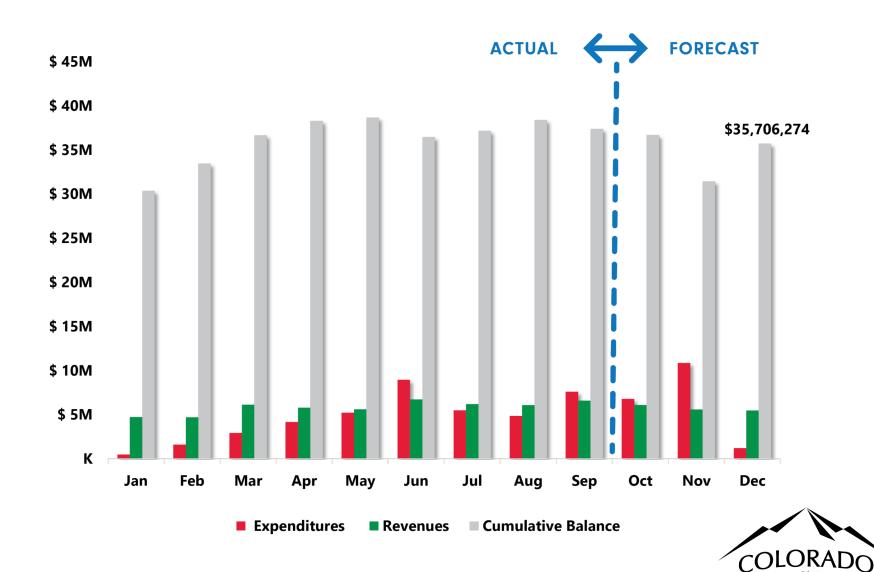

Revenues and Expenditures





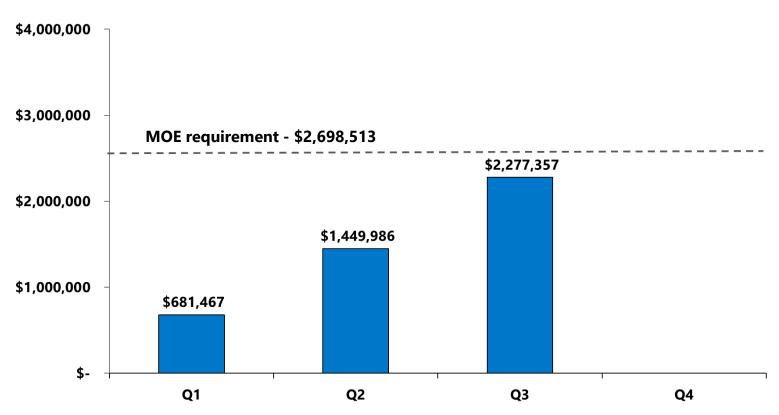
Revenues and Expenditures Forecast

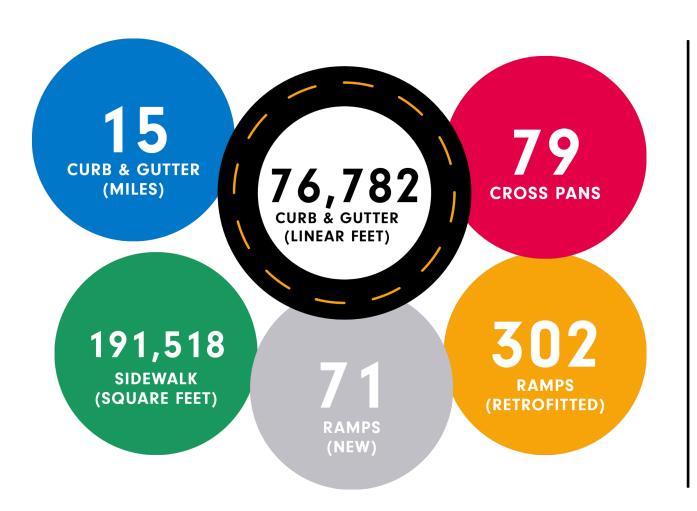

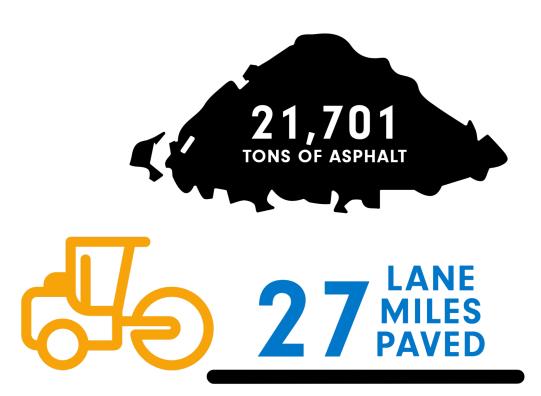

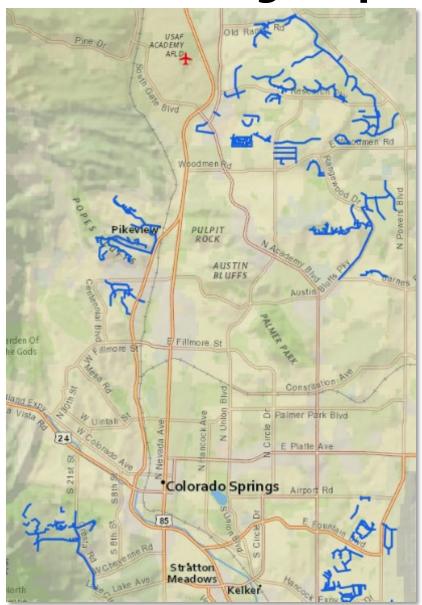
Slower concrete production in residentials has lead to several bundle deferrals
