DRY UTILITY CLEAR ZONE IS AN AREA WHERE NON-CITY UTILITIES (E.G. CABLE, FIBER, ELECTRIC) SHALL NOT BE LOCATED WITHOUT WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM CITY ENGINEERING.

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. ALL WORK SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS ENGINEERING DIVISION (THE CITY) STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL REQUIRED PERMITS. FOR CITY PERMITS (TRAFFIC/EXCAVATION) CONTRACTORS SHALL USE THE CITY'S ON-LINE PERMIT SYSTEM. ONCE CITY PERMITS ARE APPROVED AND PAID, THEN SCHEDULING AND NOTIFICATIONS SHALL BE SUBMITTED THROUGH THE ONLINE PERMITTING SYSTEM.
- 3. CONTACT THE CITY FORESTRY DIVISION, PRIOR TO STARTING WORK, IF IT IS NECESSARY TO DISTURB TREES OR ROOTS.
- 4. VAULTS SHALL NOT BE LOCATED WITHIN SIDEWALKS OR CURB RAMPS.
- 5. NO ABOVE GRADE OBJECTS SHALL BE PLACED WITHIN THE LINE OF SIGHT AS DESCRIBED IN THE ENGINEERING CRITERIA MANUAL.
- 6. ALL ABOVE GRADE STRUCTURES SHALL ADHERE TO THE CLEAR ZONE POLICY.
- 7. RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENTS SHOULD BE VERIFIED BY USING THE EL PASO COUNTY ASSESSOR'S WEBSITE.
