# REGISTRATION

Adjusted fees are available for qualifying families. Proof of approval for one of the following programs is required: free/reduced lunch program, LEAP, TANF, SSI/SSDI, WIC, SNAP, OR proof of income for 2022. **Proof must be provided PRIOR to registration to qualify for the adjusted fee online.**

## SPRAY GROUND TIPS/FOUNTAIN SAFETY

- Food is allowed in designated areas only.
- No glass containers in the spray ground area.
- For participants wearing diapers, plastic pants must be worn over the diapers (*this includes swim diapers*).
- Avoid bringing valuables. DHCC is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- All park property is designated non-smoking (*to include electronic devices, marijuana and tobacco*).
- The site will close for inclement weather.
- Parking is limited.
- No pets please.
- Please be patient and flexible as guidelines continue to change.
- If the air temperature is 65 degrees or below, the spray ground will be closed.
- If lightning is detected (within 10 miles) the spray ground will be closed.
- If we experience excessive crowding, the spray ground will be closed.
