#### **Initial City Site Goals**

- Bring a Community Park to Northeast Colorado Springs
- Build Needed Community Sport Fields
- Improve Sand Creek and the Natural Corridor
- Build this Sand Creek Trail Segment
  - Part of the planned Ring the Springs Trail



#### Concept Phase Key Takeaways

#### Program Desires Complementary to Site:

- Community Market Area flexible for many uses
- Creek Promenade integrate with overlooks
- Basketball desired by local students and public
- Sand Volleyball desire by local students
- Restrooms (or porta potties) accessible throughout park
- Drinking Fountains near active areas
- Paved and Soft Surface Walking Trails

#### Program Elements Not Included:

- Unleashed Dog park site suitability
- Disc Golf trade off for other program variety; could be added later or elsewhere
- Pump track spatial site constraint, cost, new facility coming
- Downhill Singletrack evaluating new facility & maintenance needs


#### **Concept Phase Key Takeaways**

#### **Multi-use Synthetic Sports Fields**

- Community need for more sports fields
- Multi-use complex footprint is flexible for soccer, football, baseball and frees up land for more community park use
- Synthetic turf and lights allow for more use year round







#### **Concept Phase Key Takeaways**

#### **18-20 Court Pickleball Facility**

- Non-linear layout preferred
- Minimize impact to neighbors
- Locate away from ballfields to have sufficient parking
- Focus high use activities to NW side of creek as much as possible

#### **Programming Questions**


- Limited west side parking. Is it enough?
- Timing & scheduling of events
- Requests for reduced parking on east.

#### Safety and afterhour issues (central and east side)

- Parking lots destination for crime near houses
- Security for park programming lack of visibility in core
- Trails, remote, wildlife interactions

#### Pickleball

- 20 pickleball courts needed for a tournament play
- Location good but potential engineering challenges prefers flatter central options.
- Good location to balance neighborhood concerns


#### **Community Feedback - Continued**

#### **Continued Community Interest**

- Disc Golf temporary or long term activation
- Skate Park active teen space
- Bicycle Advocacy: Pump Track, Downhill Bike Course
- Dog Park needs on the east side
- Water Play Feature besides the creek
- UC Health/RM Vibe Stadium lights, could they be swapped out for newer fixtures?

#### **Resident Requests:**

- What can be done <u>sooner</u> to address concerns for:
  - Unauthorized vehicle access on east side
  - Grassland fire mitigation
  - Unhoused people
  - Current youth and adult activity (motorbikes, teenagers, etc)

#### **Constraints & Discovery:**

Technical Considerations (Final Design, Scope & Budget):

- High bedrock limitations
- Creek Design & Improvements
- Site Drainage and Water Quality
- Utilities
- Site orientation challenge north/south field and court orientation

#### **Opportunities:**

- Creek channel improvements evaluated and implemented by City Stormwater in partnership with PRCS Staff
- Geotechnical work, support and coordination
  - Park overall and Bridge placement



#### **Right Sizing the Project**

- Ground Truthing Finish Geotechnical investigation • Creek Design, Stormwater Engineering • Planning (Funding Opportunities, Strategies, Action Plan) Mayoral and Council Transitions 30% construction document Update conceptual plan

- Set scope and budget
