

- Formed 501(c)3 non-profit in 2012—1st nationally registered PB club in CO
- Pickleball remains the fastest growing sport in America—all-age, all-skill
 - 70 PPPA members in 2012, 600 in 2016, and 1517 registered members today
 - Our youngest PPPA member is age 4, two oldest members are 91
- Mission: "to promote the Sport through Education & Training, conduct of Amateur Competitions, and helping to Reduce the Financial Burdens of local Government"
 - E&T program is one of most extensive in the Country (free public lessons, Guided Play, Round Robin leagues, Ladder Play, Skills & Drills training, and Outreach)
 - Over last 5 years, PPPA mentored 32 Pickleball start-up organizations across
 Colorado and all corners of Country (MD to FL, CA to WA, and even Sitka Alaska)
 - PPPA Co-funded MVP PB courts (\$231K), BCRP (\$121K)—and now Coleman Park in 2023 through member dues, corporate sponsorships, grants, LART funding, and tournament net proceeds
- PPPA has MOU's with both PRCS and EPC Parks to provide Open Play management and conduct of E&T programs at MVP and BCRP

- PPPA has a new Tournament Organizer and partner in US Senior Pickleball
 - USSP is the USA affiliate of the Super Senior International Pickleball Association
 - Long-term relationship based on formal agreement with specific roles & responsibilities
 - USSP brings National tournament advertising strength and tournament ops software
 - PPPA brings tournament volunteer staffing, support equipment, key gov relationships
- USSP/SSIPA conducted the Colorado PB Open at APEX for 5 previous years
 - Developed a significant tournament player following from across CO and other States
 - APEX in November 2021 raised their court rental rates from \$8 to \$30/hour/court
 - PPPA & Colorado Springs now the economic benefactors by relocating this major event

Tournament Summary







- September 9-11, 2022 (rained out on Saturday, doubled up on Sunday)
- 207 Registered Players: 97 Female/110 Male, Ages 24-84 (Avg. 59.7)
 - 41 different CO cities + 8 other States (AZ, CA, FL, IL, NC, OK, TX & WA)
 - Event planned and sized for 450 registered players (discussion to follow)
- Men's, Women's & Mixed Doubles + Men's & Women's Singles
- Four Skill Levels (3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5-5.0) per each 5-year age group
- Round Robin player-friendly format to maximize number of games played by each individual (405 games over 2 days)
- 33 PPPA vols managed 40 different pre-planning and day-of-ops tasks





















Tournament Takeaways

- BIG well-deserved Thank You to the PRCS staff
 - Blake Zink Event Coordinator went well out of his way helping with our park application and securing additional parking for players
 - Shawn Riley and his maintenance team dried the courts with industrial leaf blowers and quite literally saved our tournament after the Saturday rain-out (allowed us to double-up play on Sunday)
- Needed PRCS scheduling policy to protect from "for-profit" encroachment to increase tournament revenue designated for future CoS court development; e.g., Coleman Park

Colorado Springs Pickleball Classic

- 184 Registered Players
- World PB Tour [for-profit] with a "5K Cash Prize" (Columbus OH)
- > Players generally do not pay and play in back-to-back tournament events
- > PPPA is ONLY Pickleball entity where tournament profits stay in CoS to help co-fund <u>local</u> court development (Monument Valley Park, Bear Creek Park, and Coleman Park in 2023)
- ➤ Both of these other "for-profit" tournaments were attracted to CoS because of very low court/event fees which decreased their expenses and increased their profit—diluting PPPA tournament attendance and resulting PPPA/Colorado Springs' financial loss (up to \$19,000)
- ▶ Recommendations: 1) PRCS policy to preserve 2 weekends on either side of the CO PB Open—PPoB tournament still leaving 13 other weekends (72%) to book 3-4 other PB events; and 2) Increase PRCS PB Court Rental Fees to just undercut those of APEX (\$30/hour/court) to ~\$20 hour/court

Available 2023 Weekend PB Tournament Dates

- 18 weekend dates from June through September
- 2023 CO PB Open—Pikes Peak or Bust tournament is now planned for August 10-13 after de-conflicting with RMSG
- Blocking two weekends before and after allows 13 additional weekends to schedule other PB events at MVP, including RMSG



Observations: (based on Visiting Player Survey w/ 89% response rate)

- Significant Economic Benefit-related growth since 2014 and 2015 in
 - Registered players, local participation, & visiting players/friends/family
 - Room Nights (up 163% in 2 years)
 - Economic Benefit for CoS tourism-related businesses
- New 15-court venue + PPPA/C&VB campaign to make CoS a family vacation destination for visiting PB tournament players is working well
