

Park Vista Drainage Improvements Project & Annexation

The City of Colorado Springs Stormwater Enterprise (SWENT), in cooperation with El Paso County, is developing a plan to improve storm drainage in the Park Vista South Neighborhood. The improvements will address drainage and flooding issues that have historically impacted the Templeton Gap Floodway alignment located between the western intersection of Siferd Boulevard and Date Street to Hopeful Drive.

El Paso County has approved an agreement to annex the rights-of-way in the Park Vista South area into the City of Colorado Springs. Transferring ownership responsibilities to the City will streamline maintenance and flood mitigation efforts. In addition to the roadway rights-of-way, and County and City-owned lots being annexed into the City, the remaining lots currently in the County have the option to be annexed into the City.
