

South Downtown Railroad Underpass Reconstruction

About the Project

The Colorado Springs South Downtown Rail Underpass Reconstruction project (SDRUR) would address safety and operational issues along the rail corridor and improve transportation connectivity for all travel modes to downtown Colorado Springs.

Planned improvements include:

- 1 Replacing three railroad bridges at Nevada Avenue, Tejon Street, and Shooks Run
- Replacing the Las Vegas Street Roadway over Shooks Run bridge
- 3 Improving Tejon Street and Nevada Avenue from Fountain Boulevard to Mill Street
- Improving neighborhood streets and sidewalks
- 5 Creating quiet zones and improving pedestrian access at Sierra Madre Street and Las Animas Street
- 6 Planning for future connection of the Legacy Loop trail
