Note to Applicant

ID documents are necessary for ALL fingerprinting and badging transactions.

Please note - laminated Social Security Cards are *not* acceptable. All applicants requiring Driving Privileges MUST present a valid Driver's License.

If you were born outside of the United States (as a citizen or not) a Social Security card is NOT acceptable, extra documentation is required. Please see examples below or call Airport Badging @ (719) 550-1936 for clarification.

LISTS OF ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS

All documents containing an expiration date must be unexpired.

* Documents extended by the issuing authority are considered unexpired.

Employees may present one selection from List A or a combination of one selection from List B and one selection from List C.

Examples of many of these documents appear in the Handbook for Employers (M-274).
